Breathe, enjoy, wonder... there's so much to explore!



It was the first resort in the Southern Alps to be awarded the Flocon Vert label in 2018 by the Mountain Riders association, followed by its renewal with 2 flocons level in 2022.

One thing's for sure: there's never a dull moment!

















SNOWSHOE TRAILS

More than 40 kilometers of marked snowshoe trails allow you to fully enjoy the mountain in winter. Valberg - Beuil-les-Launes

With 56 ski slopes at altitudes from 1,500 to 2,066 meters, as well as fun facilities for the youngest skiers, the Valberg ski area is renowned for being accessible to all, whatever their level.

As the birthplace of skiing with the village of Beuil and the oldest resort in the Alpes-Maritimes, Valberg offers an area equipped with fun and modern facilities.

An ideal playground for nearly 90 years, where everyone can enjoy themselves safely. With varied altitudes, clear views, and sunny panoramas, enjoy a little piece of paradise to enhance your days on the slopes!

An exceptional area surrounded by mountain villages and wilderness.

With 25km of cross-country skiing slopes spread across slopes, both young and old can ski in the best conditions throughout the winter season. A beginner area, recently equipped with swow guns, also allows for full enjoyment of the snow throughout the season.

La Sagne : green = 900m long = +10m elevation
 L'Infernet : red = 3,3km long = +40m elevation
 Cumba Clava : red = 11km long = +130m elevation
 Plateau Saint Jean : red = 10km = +300m elevation





Valberg LABELLED VILLAGE



Recognized nationally and internationally, the Flocon Vert judges candidate resorts on the basis of some twenty criteria, divided into four categories: governance and destination, local economy, social and cultural, natural resources and ecology. Valberg is labelled since 2018.



Since 2019, Valberg is part of the Alpes Azur Mercantour territory labelled « International Dark Sky Places» by the US-based IDA (International Dark Sky Association). Rewarding territoires for being active in the protection of the starry sky & night biodiversity.





Created by the French Ministry of Tourism, the Qualité Tourisme mark recognizes continuous

improvement in service quality implemented by Tourist Offices. It is a real guarantee of trust and quality of service between professionals and visitors. It will be replaced in 2026 by the Destination d'Excellence label, towards which Valberg is already making its transition today.



Awarded in 2018 for 12 years, this classification recognizes the efforts made by a local authority to structure an adapted tourism offer and excellent hospitality.



Valberg has held the Famille Plus label since 2006, and does everything in its power to offer families

SITS SURROUNDINGS

Natural areas

Located at the gateway to the Mercantour National Park and close to the Daluis Gorge Regional Nature Reserve, Valberg works with local stakeholders to contribute to the protection of the surrounding areas that make the beauty and magic of the region.

The Mercantour National Park, established in 1979, offers breathtaking landscapes, exceptional biodiversity, and endless hiking opportunities. It preserves wild nature, perfect for adventure enthusiasts.

The Gorges de Daluis regional nature reserve is the only regional nature reserve in the Alpes-Maritimes department, created in 2012, reveals impressive landscapes of red canyons sculpted by the river, offering an ideal setting for hikers and nature lovers.





Péone, an authentic village



Nestled at the foot of impressive rocky peaks known as «Les Aiguilles» and at the confluence of two rivers, the village appears to be protected by the sometimes tumultuous nature surrounding it.

It is by strolling through the pedestrian, shaded streets of the old village that one discovers the beauty and authenticity of this picturesque place, which hides some remarkable features, such as its half-timbered houses and the reuse of many elements that once belonged to the now-gone castle.





Valberg 2025

DEPARTMENTAL ENVIRONMENT AND OBSERVATION CENTER



SCHEDULED OPENING IN SEPTEMBER 2025

This major project, supported by the Alpes Maritimes department and the Valberg resort, began in November 2022 and will be completed in September 2025. The project is part of the 'Bâtiments Durables Méditerranéens' (Mediterranean Sustainable Buildings) programme, and has been awarded the 'Gold' level, guaranteeing a high level of energy and environmental quality, while taking into account local social and economic issues.

This space dedicated to environmental awareness and education will bring together several major partners, including the Communauté de Communes Alpes d'Azur and its protected areas (Gorges de Daluis regional nature reserve and Natura 2000 areas), the Mercantour National Park, the departmental media library and the 226-seat cinema.

This future centre for learning, meeting and sharing will enhance the resort's existing 4-season offering, providing a wide range of events, lectures, planetarium sessions and much more throughout the year, with sustainable development and the preservation of the region as its central themes.

The new building will be home to an immersive dome measuring 12 metres in diameter and seating 50 to 100 people (seated or standing), which will be used mainly for planetarium screenings, but also for immersive concerts and shows, as well as digital visual arts performances. Finally, the large lobby of over 400 m² has been designed as a fully modular educational and exhibition space, for a multitude of uses throughout the year.


Throughout summer and winter, free electric shuttles run around the village. Schedules available at the Tourist Office and on the PYSAE app.
